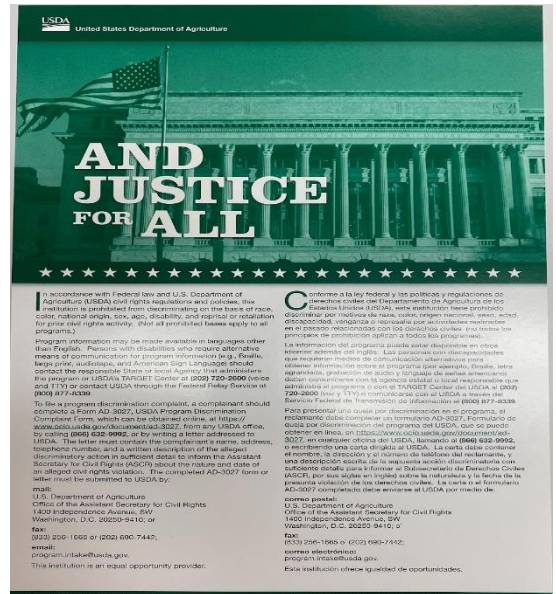
Potato Soup

Ingredients: Potatoes, Onion, Milk, and Butter.

Directions: Begin by chopping the potatoes and onions. Then add the diced potatoes and onions to the slow cooker or pot along with water. Cook until tender. Once the potato chunks are falling apart, remove 1 cup of the cooking water and discard. Add in butter along with 1 cup of milk, then carefully put in the blender to blend until creamy and smooth.

Recertifications

- Clients are required to provide a photo ID and a utility bill during recertification.
- All clients must be in person to complete an application.
- Ensure that the green Justice for All poster (as shown) is displayed where the clients can see it during distributions.
